**ELIGIBILITY-** This show is open to all artists and is a unique Combined Show of our two annual juried shows: Fiber and Regional Shows, with a Fiber category included in this Show. This is a JURIED show: This means that we will have a panel of jurists to decide which pieces are allowed into the show. Please note that the jurors may choose as appropriate for this show anywhere from zero to all three of the works you submit. Fee is non-refundable.

Only one application per artist is allowed.

**SUBMISSION FORM is online.** Once you pay your fee, a submission form will be emailed to you.

**AWARDS:** BEST IN SHOW: \$300. Cash prizes – (first, second and third place in each category) also awarded in these categories:

- **2-D** (“flat” work on canvas),
- **3-D** (works that can viewed from all sides, including pottery),
- **Photography, and**
- **Fiber**

**APPROVAL BY COMMITTEE:** The MWCA committee reserves the right at drop-off to reject any artwork due to size (no larger than 40” x 40”, framed) and weight limitations or inappropriateness. Even if juried into the show via our online process, if the piece presented at drop-off does not meet all guidelines, the work will not be allowed into the show.

**SECURITY:** Reasonable security is provided for the duration of the exhibition. Care will be taken in the handling, hanging and displaying of the work. However, MWCA will not be held responsible or liable for the loss or damage of any art.

**Artwork left longer than 30 days** after the closing of the show will become the property of MWCA.

## ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

**We reserve the right to refuse any work not meeting these specifications. Art must hang for the duration of the show. All artwork (even fiber) must be delivered ready to be hung.**

- All work must be original, not previously shown at MWCA, completed without assistance. For juried shows: Works are not allowed that were produced during workshops or classes.
- Fiber arts: Works made from patterns and general directions for knitting, weaving, quilting, rug hooking etc. are permitted; however, works made from kits are not.
- All flat work must **have a wire on the back**. (No saw tooth hangers).
- Work that is not secured into the frame will not be hung.
- If you choose to enter work on a non-framed canvas, paint must be on the edges. Attach wire on back.
- All paint must be dry.
- Charcoal & pastels must be fixed.
- Sculpture must be sturdy and able to stand on its own.
- MWCA takes a 25% on all sales, so please price accordingly.
- Work does not have to be for sale but, we prefer that it be.
