2023 SCHEDULE FOR HANGING YOUR STUDENTS' WORKS:

If you see any problems/conflicts with this schedule, please let me know ASAP. Hope you all can participate!

ELEMENTARY

- Install Feb 22-23
- Opens Feb 24
- Closing reception & art pick up March 16 from 6 – 7:30

MIDDLE

- Install March 17-20
- Opens March 21
- Closing reception & art pick up April 13 from 6 – 7:30

HIGH

- Install April 14-17
- Opens April 18
- Closing reception & art pick up May 18 from 6 – 7:30

GENERAL INFO

We are open these hours: Sunday 1 – 5, Monday 11 – 4, Tues-Thurs 11-5, Friday-Saturday 10-5. We are always open during those hours. You don't have to call first to make sure we are open.

I'm very flexible and if you call me I will do my best to accommodate your schedule – to come in early or stay late etc.

TEXTING is wonderful, as I am very busy. IF you don't have my cell number please let me know and I will share it with you. I will do my best to work with you.

If you can get here before we close, I can leave you here to finish setting up your area. That's fine with me, but I would like some advance notice. You must get here before I leave. I can't have people coming into the building without at least knowing who you are. I hope that makes sense.

NUMBER OF 4 x 8 panels allocated to each teacher:

We have a total of 32 of the 4' x 8' "sides" (16 standards). Not all our teachers participate, but if they did, here is how many "sides" of the boards/standards you need to fill.

- ELEMENTARY: 3 (so that's 1.5 standards)
- MIDDLE: 6 (3 standards, front and back)
- HIGH: 6 (3 standards, front and back)

SCAD

As far as I know, SCAD will be judging our High School show as usual and awarding scholarships to winners.

ART FOR SALE!

You might be surprised how many times we are asked if certain works are available for purchase. If your student would like to offer their piece for sale, please note "AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE \$---" on the label. You may also mark other pieces NFS (Not For Sale) if you wish. Standard rates apply: 75% to the student, 25% to MWCA.

POLICY

Please remember that this is a family-centered community art center. Young children are regularly in and out of here. Please - no works depicting violence or illegal activities or drug use. Let's keep the message here positive and uplifting; not disturbing or frightening. Our gallery committee reserves the right to either move or remove works that do not fit the family-friendly policy.

FOR NEWBIES

Our boards are covered in indoor-outdoor carpet. You can use T Pins or Velcro to hang your works. Most teachers mat the hanging works in black or white.

You can purchase just the "hook" side of Velcro dots in large quantities. Here is a link from Amazon; I'm sure there are other places to get this as

Please label each piece with the:

- student's name
- grade
- school
- media if possible
- **high school: a name for each piece so that the judges can list which piece is chosen.**

I will send a flyer for your show that you can distribute to your students and hang in your school.

RECEPTION

Please note the date of your reception and try to attend. Students will take their works home that night. If the student is not here, you are responsible for taking the works with you. Please do not leave items behind.

Also please ask your parents to provide snacks for your reception. MWCA provides the paper goods and ice.

These shows are super popular and appreciated by our community. You wouldn't believe how often I hear something like, "My art was displayed here when I was a kid." You probably don't realize the impact these shows make and how proud the kids are!
